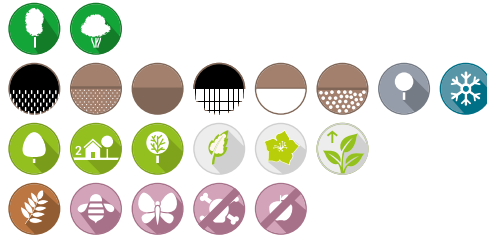




## Acer negundo 'Flamingo'

| <b>Height</b>                | 5 - 7 m, fast growing                                                            |
| <b>Width</b>                 | 5-7m                                                                             |
| <b>Crown</b>                 | egg-shaped, later wide egg-shaped, half-open crown                               |
| <b>Bark and branches</b>     | young twigs shiny green and pruinose                                             |
| <b>Leaf</b>                  | unevenly feathered, silver-white with a pink margin, up to 20 cm, feathered leaf |
| <b>Flowers</b>               | in thick bundles, before the leaves appear, April                                |
| <b>Fruits</b>                | none, fruitless cultivar                                                         |
| <b>Spines/thorns</b>         | None                                                                             |
| <b>Toxicity</b>              | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock                          |
| <b>Soil type</b>             | few requirements, also in calcareous soil                                        |
| <b>Paving</b>                | tolerates no paving                                                              |
| <b>Winter hardiness zone</b> | 5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)                                                           |
| <b>Wind resistance</b>       | moderate                                                                         |
| <b>Other resistances</b>     | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)                                                    |
| <b>Fauna tree</b>            | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies                          |
| <b>Application</b>           | industrial areas, small gardens, patio gardens                                   |
| <b>Shape</b>                 | clearstem tree, multi-stem treem                                                 |
| <b>Origin</b>                | J. Bastiaanse, Oudenbosch, The Netherlands, 1976                                 |

A fast growing, medium-sized tree, reaching a maximum height of 7 m. This cultivar differs little from the other cultivars of the A. negundo with variegated leaves. The leaves are green with silver-white to light-pink margins. Young unfurling leaves have a nice light-pink colour. 'Flamingo' can be applied in parks and gardens. The tree grows both on wet and dry sites. It has a deep rooting main root which branches out strongly. Regular pruning will stimulate the growth of finely coloured young sprouts.
