## Fraxinus excelsior 'Aurea Pendula'

Fraxinus excelsior 'Aurea Pendula' is a relatively slow-growing tree with strikingly yellow twigs. The branches are strongly pendulous giving it a nice weeping look. It can attain a height of 5 - 8 m. The compound leaf is light green in summer and has a yellow autumn colour. 'Aurea Pendula' does not bear flowers and fruits and is used as a solitary and a park tree and in gardens. The tree prefers rich, moist soil. Winter hardiness zone:
