



## Gleditsia triacanthos 'Globosa'



<b>Height</b>	2-4 m
<b>Width</b>	2-4m
<b>Crown</b>	round/spherical, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green, feathered leaf
<b>Autumn colour</b>	yellow
<b>Flowers</b>	light green, flowers in June
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for dry soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
<b>Application</b>	tree containers
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree

A spherical-shaped shrub, often grafted on a stem. This generates a compact growing, small tree with a height to circa 4 m. The understock is usually *G. triacanthos* f. *inermis*, which has a grey colour and has fine, shallow fissures. 'Globosa' is a spineless variety. The compound leaf is sometimes pinnate and sometimes twice-pinnate, unfolds late and turns golden yellow in autumn. It is 15 to 20 cm in size. The single leaflets are circa 2 cm. This cultivar does not flower and as a consequence does not bear pods. Tolerant to hard surfaces. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
