A very winter-hardy ornamental apple tree with a round crown. The tree can attain a height of 5 - 6 m. In the spring the oval leaves are purplish but later they turn dark green. Deep dark red flower buds give way to purplish-pink single flowers with a diameter of approx. 4 - 5 cm. The bright red fruits are 2 - 2.5 cm in size. 'Makamik' can be used in parks and public gardens. The tree makes heavy demands on the soil as regards moisture supply and fertility. 'Makamik' is not very sensitive to scab. Winter hardiness zone: 4
