



Populus x canadensis 'Ellert'



Height	20-25 m, fast growing
Width	12-15m
Crown	oval, half-open crown
Bark and branches	brown, grey
Leaf	green
Flowers	red, flowers in April
Fruits	fruitless cultivar
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardness zone	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	avenues and broad streets, coastal areas
Shape	clearstem tree

Populus x canadensis 'Ellert' A fast grower with a fairly straight trunk and relatively thin branches. The tree has a broad oval crown with irregular branching. Adult specimens can reach a height of 20 - 25 m. The leaves start out light green but later turn a darker shade. Bears flowers in the form of male catkins. 'Ellert' shows good resistance to rust and canker and is resistant to leaf spot disease. It is used in forestry and in coastal areas because of its good resistance to wind. Winter hardness zone: 4
