



## Prunus 'Trailblazer'



<b>Height</b>	5-7 m
<b>Width</b>	3-5m
<b>Crown</b>	round/spherical, dark, dense crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	brown
<b>Leaf</b>	green, reddish brown, yellowgreen
<b>Flowers</b>	cream white, flowers in April
<b>Fruits</b>	edible fruits, red
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates partial paving
<b>Winter hardness zone</b>	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	moderate
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
<b>Application</b>	small gardens, patio gardens
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, multi-stem tree
<b>Synonyms</b>	Prunus cerasifera 'Hollywood', Prunus cerasifera 'Trailblazer'

Prunus 'Trailblazer' (syn: P. cerasifera 'Hollywood', P.c. 'Trailblazer') is a small tree with a rounded crown. Height approx. 5 - 7 m. The leaves emerge dark green but very quickly turn dark brownish-green. They maintain the latter colour throughout the season. The relatively small, creamy-white flowers are contained in pale pink flower buds. They open in the first half of April and are approx. 2 cm in diameter. Large, dark red, tasty fruits follow in late summer. Winter hardness zone: 5a
