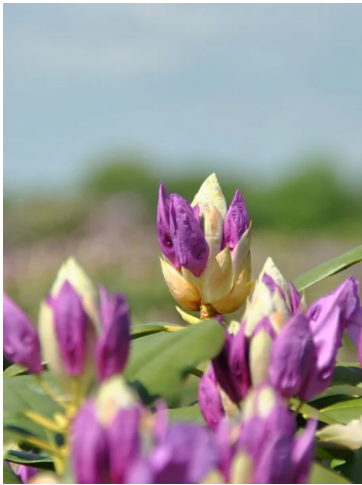




# Rhododendron 'Catawbiense Grandiflorum'

| Height                | 2,5 - 4 m                                     |
| Width                 | 2,5-4m                                        |
| Crown                 | round/spherical, dark, dense crown            |
| Leaf                  | green, evergreen                              |
| Flowers               | flowers in May, June                          |
| Spines/thorns         | None                                          |
| Toxicity              | has toxic components                          |
| Soil type             | loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil |
| Paving                | tolerates partial paving                      |
| Winter hardiness zone | 4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)                         |
| Other resistances     | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)                 |
| Application           | tree containers, roof gardens, patio gardens  |
| Shape                 | large blooming hybrids                        |

This is a very well-known old rhododron resembling the 'Catawbiense Boursault'. However, the leaves are smoother and the flowers are a bit smaller and a lighter purple.
