TREEVOLUTION 'Cyrilles Clean'

Height	20 - 25 (30) m, fast-growing
Crown	spherical, dense crown
Bark and branches	thin, brown and smooth bark, sticky buds
Leaf	palmate, 5/7-tall, dark green, circa 20 cm, free of infestation leaf miner moth
Flowers	white, erect panicles, May/June
Fruits	spiny, with 1 to 3 shiny brown chestnuts
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	Low requirements, can tolerate paving, no asphalt
Soil moisture	withstand short flood
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardiness zone	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate to good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	avenues and broad streets
Shape	clearstem tree
Origin	South-eastern Europe, northern Iran to the western Himalayas

Large tree with broad, wavy crown and a short, sturdy trunk. Very tightly closed crown, creating heavy shade. Adult specimens can reach 30 m in height with a width of over 20 m. The opposite leaves can reach 20 cm in diameter. They turn yellow-brown in autumn. The inflorescence is profuse and white, in 20 - 25 cm long erect panicles. The colouring of the macula (spot in the flower) from yellow to red is striking. What is special about this cultivar is that Cyrilles Clean stays virtually completely free of infestation by the Horse chestnut moth (Cameraria ohridella).
