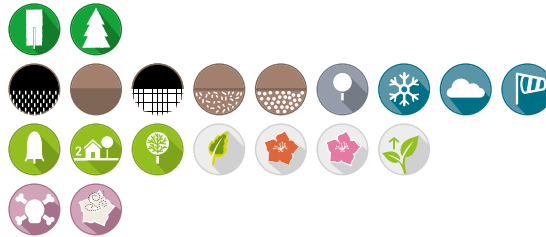




# Chamaecyparis lawsoniana

| Height                | 6-8 m                                                      |
| Width                 | 2-2,5m                                                     |
| Crown                 | narrow weeping, dark, dense crown                          |
| Bark and branches     | flaking, reddisch brown                                    |
| Leaf                  | variegated, green/yellow, evergreen                        |
| Flowers               | pinkred, flowers in April, fragrant flowers                |
| Fruits                | reddisch brown                                             |
| Spines/thorns         | None                                                       |
| Toxicity              | has toxic components                                       |
| Soil type             | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil |
| Paving                | tolerates no paving                                        |
| Winter hardiness zone | 6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)                                     |
| Wind resistance       | good                                                       |
| Other resistances     | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind          |
| Application           | industrial areas, small gardens, patio gardens             |
| Shape                 | specimen conifer, hedge plant                              |
