



Ginkgo biloba 'Autumn Gold'



Height	15-25 m
Width	9-12m
Crown	broad conical, light, open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	brown, grey
Leaf	green
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	green, flowers in April
Fruits	fruitless cultivar
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, all soil types
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardiness zone	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
Wind resistance	fairly to good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	avenues and broad streets, tree containers, roof gardens, industrial areas
Shape	clearstem tree, feathered tree, multi-stem treem, clearstem conifer, specimen conifer

An American selection with a uniform manner of growth, initially narrow pyramidal, later broad pyramidal. The main trunk grows straight and branches grow in an open pattern. Height 15 - 25 m, width to approx. 15 m. Slow-growing, particularly when young. The fan-shaped leaves and flower buds are on short shoots. The leaves grow in bundles of 3 - 5 together and have an incised top. The lovely golden yellow colouration in the autumn, one of the selection criteria for 'Autumn Gold' adds extra decorative value. It is a male selection without fruit, thus suitable as avenue and street tree. It requires a site with ample light and tolerates heat well. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
