Fraxinus ornus 'Louisa Lady'



Height	6 - 10 m
Width	4-5m
Crown	broad oval, light, open crown
Bark and branches	grey-brown, smooth
Leaf	imparipinnate, 5 - 7 leaflets, glossy dark green, feathered leaf
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	cream white, in dense terminal panicles, pleasantl fragrant, may/june, fragrant flowers
Fruits	winged nut, produces few fruits
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	drier calcareous soils
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardiness zone	7 (-17,7 to -12,3 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
Application	avenues and broad streets, tree containers, roof gardens, coastal areas, industrial areas
Shape	clearstem tree
Origin	Ton van den Oever b.v., 1980

Fairly slow growing, elegant, medium-size tree with an open, broad oval crown, eventually up to about 10 m in height. Forms a straight central leader. The leaves are glossy dark green, turning golden yellow in autumn. Around May/June, after the leaves emerge, the dense panicles of creamy white flowers appear. The flowers are deliciously fragrant and stand out well against the dark green background of the leaves. Large street tree that can also be used in paved surfaces. Tolerates air pollution, (sea) wind and a certain amount of road salt. Prefers dryer, preferably calcareous soils.
