| Height | 6-8 m |
| Crown | round/spherical |
| Bark and branches | brown, grey |
| Leaf | green |
| Flowers | whitepink, flowers in March |
| Fruits | edible fruits, redgreen |
| Spines/thorns | None |
| Toxicity | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock |
| Soil type | clay soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil |
| Paving | tolerates paving |
| Winter hardiness zone | 4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C) |
| Wind resistance | good, susceptible to sea wind |
| Other resistances | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind |
| Fauna tree | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds |
| Application | parks, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens |
| Shape | clearstem tree, clearstem fruit tree |
