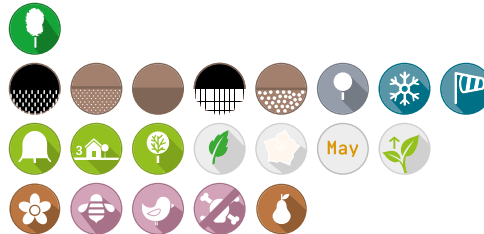




Malus 'Red Jade'



Height	4-5 m
Width	3-4m
Crown	broad weeping, half-open crown
Bark and branches	brown
Leaf	green
Flowers	white, flowers in May
Fruits	red
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	3 (-40,0 to -24,5 °C)
Wind resistance	good, susceptible to sea wind
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds
Application	tree containers, industrial areas, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	clearstem tree

Malus 'Red Jade' has a broad weeping crown with thin pendulous branches. Height 4 - 5 m. The oval tapered leaves are bright green. The flower buds are purplish-red: the flowers open in early May and are white and single. Flower diameter Ø 3 - 4 cm. 'Red Jade' produces glossy red, oval fruits that stay on the tree for a long time, Ø 1 - 1.5 cm. The tree does not support hard surfaces and is used as a solitary. It makes heavy demands on the soil as regards moisture supply and fertility. Winter hardiness zone: 3
