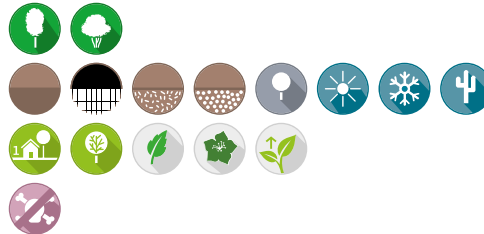




## Morus digitata

| <b>Height</b>                | 10-15 m                                                         |
| <b>Width</b>                 | 7-12m                                                           |
| <b>Crown</b>                 | round/spherical, half-open crown                                |
| <b>Bark and branches</b>     | grey                                                            |
| <b>Leaf</b>                  | green                                                           |
| <b>Flowers</b>               | green, flowers in May                                           |
| <b>Spines/thorns</b>         | None                                                            |
| <b>Toxicity</b>              | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock         |
| <b>Soil type</b>             | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, all soil types |
| <b>Soil moisture</b>         | suitable for dry soil                                           |
| <b>Paving</b>                | tolerates no paving                                             |
| <b>Winter hardiness zone</b> | 5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)                                          |
| <b>Wind resistance</b>       | moderate                                                        |
| <b>Other resistances</b>     | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)                                   |
| <b>Shape</b>                 | clearstem tree, multi-stem treem                                |
