



## Populus ×canescens 'Schubu'



<b>Height</b>	20-25 m
<b>Width</b>	10-15m
<b>Crown</b>	oval, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green
<b>Flowers</b>	grey, flowers in March
<b>Fruits</b>	fruitless cultivar
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil, calcareous soil
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for wet soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
<b>Application</b>	coastal areas
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree

This is a selection from Germany with a broad upright to oval crown. It is a fast-growing tree with a slightly sinuous trunk. The leaves are broad ovoid and somewhat similar to those of *P. tremula*, but have a straight leaf base. 'Schubu' tolerates (sea) wind and is suitable for landscape planting. The tree also grows in dry places and has good resistance to rust. However, the tree is susceptible to cancer. Hardiness zone: 5a
